MORE FEDERAL \$\$\$ FOR AIRPORT FACILITIES!

The U.S. federal government has provided Plattsburgh International Airport with an additional **\$2.37 MILLION** as part of its continuing commitment to enhancing aviation facilities at the site. The latest funding comes from the Military Airports Program -- a special program targeting select former Air Force Bases which are seen as the best bets for commercial development.

This most recent grant will be used by the airport to **construct additional hangar space for private jets and other general aviation aircraft**, addressing the growing demand at Plattsburgh by private and corporate plane owners. Users and tenants are being attracted by the uncongested facilities, access to fairly priced fuel, and the quality FBO services provided by **SheltAir** -- as well as the convenient location near Lake Placid and the Adirondacks, and Montreal.

The airport has received almost **\$40 million** under this federal program for various facilities, including hangar upgrades and the construction of a new passenger terminal. Overall, the federal and New York State governments have provided more than \$80 million to Plattsburgh for the on-going redevelopment of the former Plattsburgh Air Force Base as "**MONTREAL'S U.S. AIRPORT**".
